FIELD SUPERVISOR

SALARY AND BENEFITS:

The District offers competitive pay and a strong benefits package. Starting salary is **\$52,000 per year**. This position is non-exempt, salaried, full-time, year-round, and includes medical, dental, vision, and life insurance. Retirement benefits are through the Washington State Public Employees Retirement System (WA PERS) and ICMA-RC.

POSITION SUMMARY:

Directly supervises the complete field program and related support services. Evaluates on a continuing basis the work performed, making adjustments as necessary to insure the success of the control program and compliance with District policies. Exercises independent judgment in hiring, evaluating, transferring, disciplining and discharging employees. Conducts scientific and technical inspections; develops and maintains records to comply with state regulations. Conducts continuing public education programs. Responsible for the District safety program.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Train and supervise field staff
- Pesticide ordering and inventory
- Coordinate aerial and ground applications of larval and adult mosquito control products
- Communicate effectively with the public and municipal leaders

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Incumbent should possess a four-year college degree in biological sciences, or a directly related field of study, with a minimum of two years of mosquito control or pesticide application experience in a supervisory role. High school graduation and five or more years of mosquito control experience may be substituted; college training of 30 semester hours may be counted as one half years' experience.
